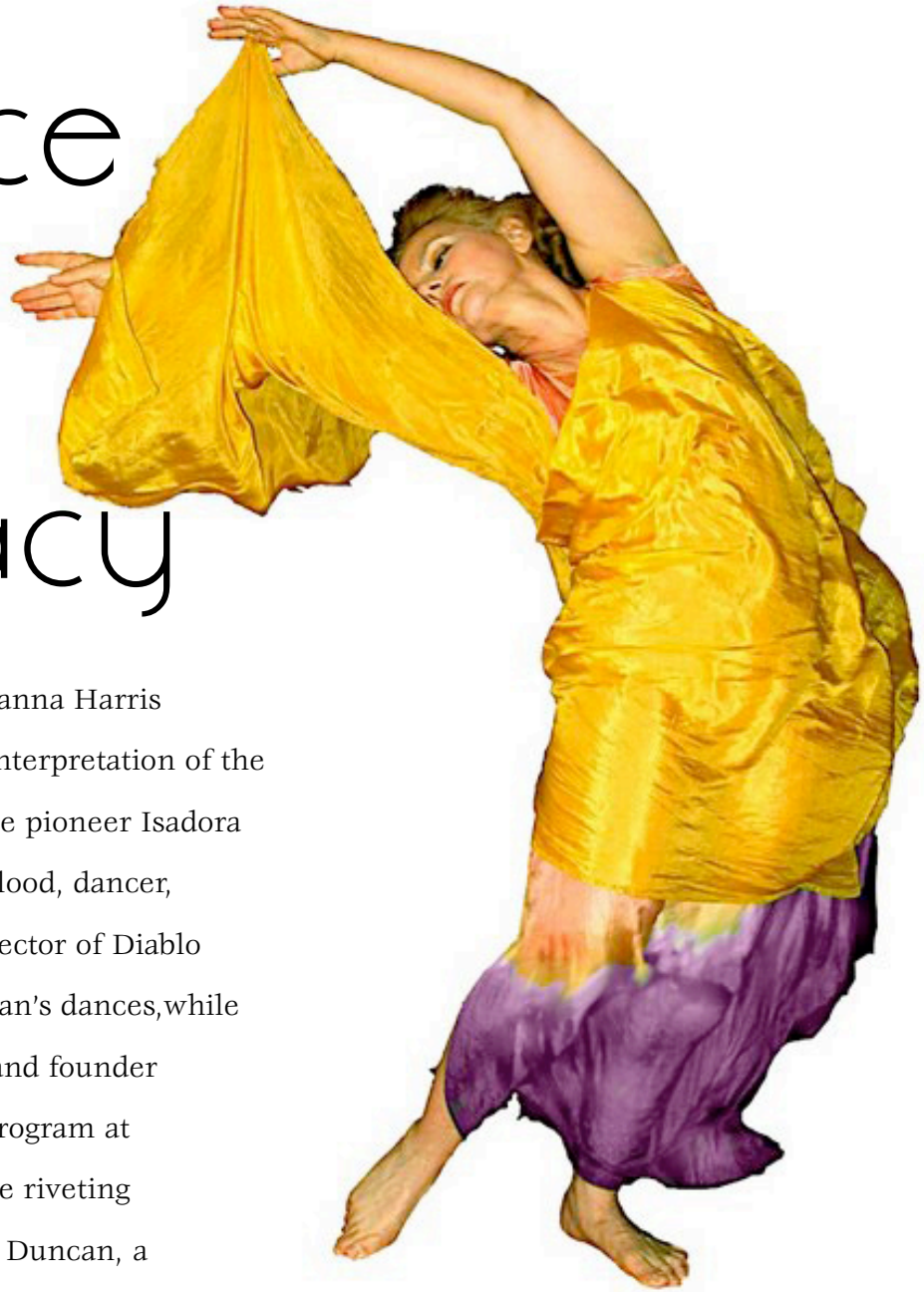


Isadora Duncan's Dance and Legacy

native of San Francisco, is credited
with inventing a free-flowing dance style
